Women have no independence at any time." [4] Now it is clearly says, that era women had no freedom to work in external environment of the home and they had to live under the control of men inside the four walls of their houses.

The condition of women was more serious during the medieval ages, especially during the Muslim rule in India. Many customs came into present that pretend to feel women unfavorable. Many social practices of that time went against women. Keeping women out of sight of the muslim enter in large number of women gave rise to baneful veil (pardah) system. In this way, women lost their all freedom and they became unable to succeed in doing work outside their houses and nobody focused on the women's professional education and skills of women. The family members and relatives saved money for their marriage but not saved for developing skills of women. They don't want to expend money for their education or learning.

In post independence era, the position of Indian women did not improve much except some field such as health and education. In our country, for a long time the field of public service was not opened for women. They were treated as weak and hence required to remain within the four walls of their parental or matrimonial home to attend to house hold and domestic duties like food preparation, clean-up, and looking after children and old age members of the family. Even today, in certain Indian communities, there is restriction in allowing women to work external.

Management scientists and psychologists have found that females are not present in every way, substandard to males.
